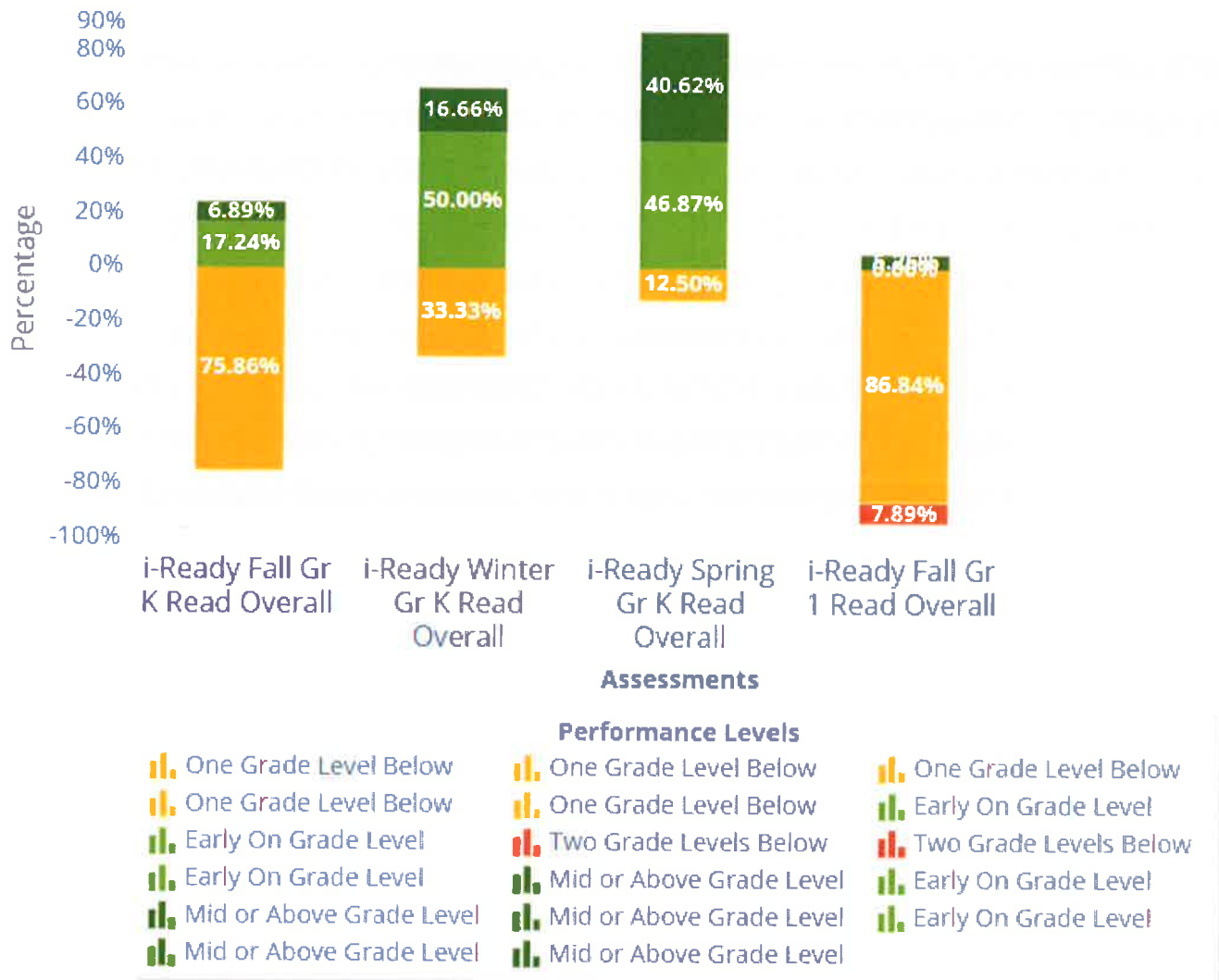

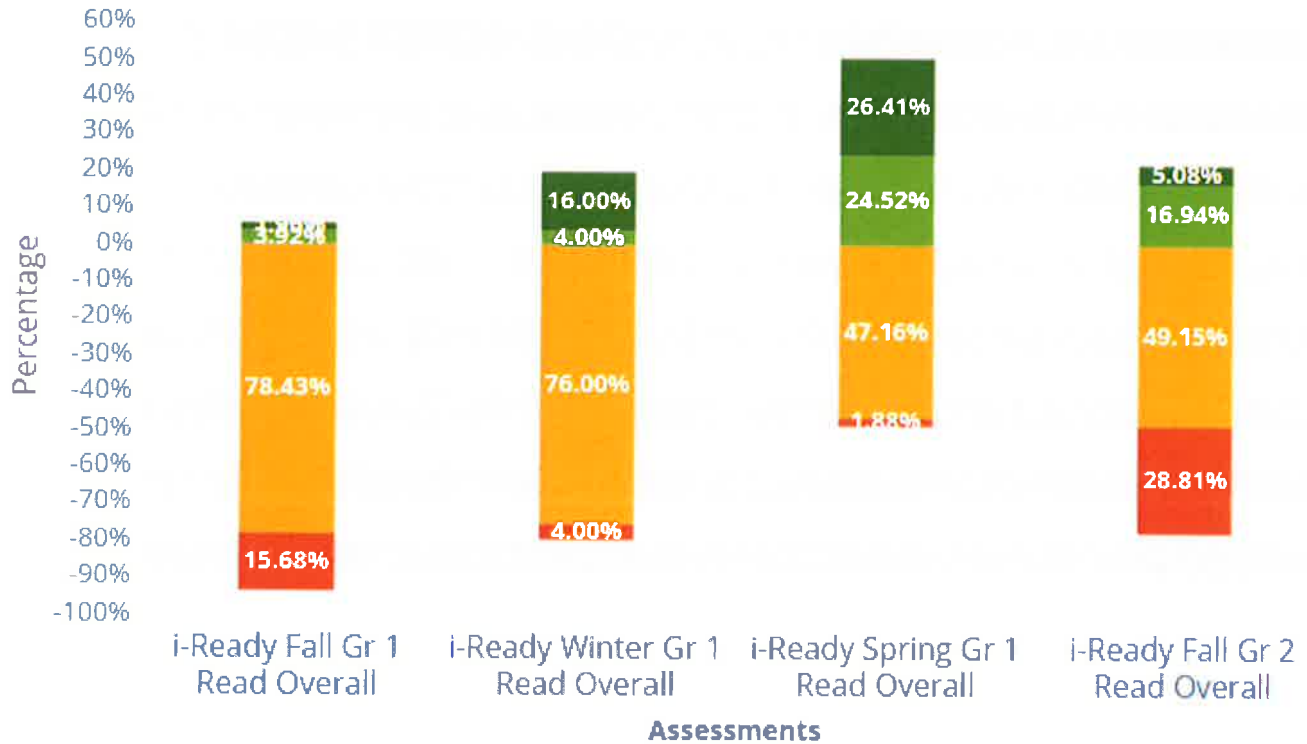

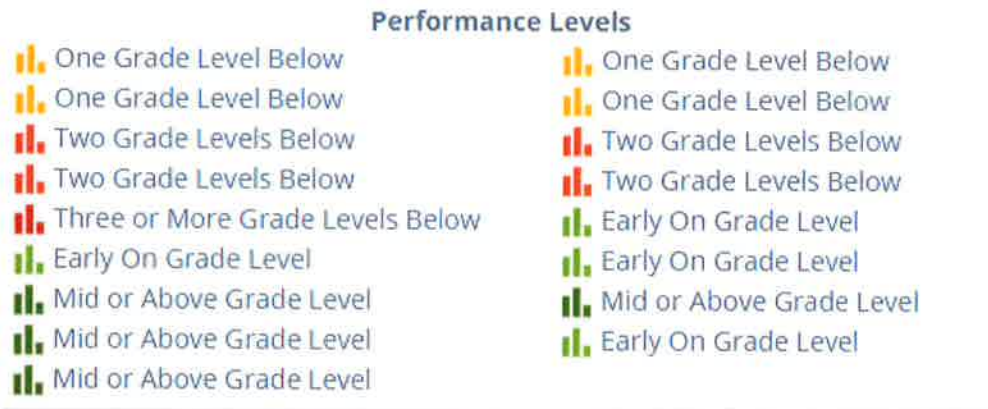

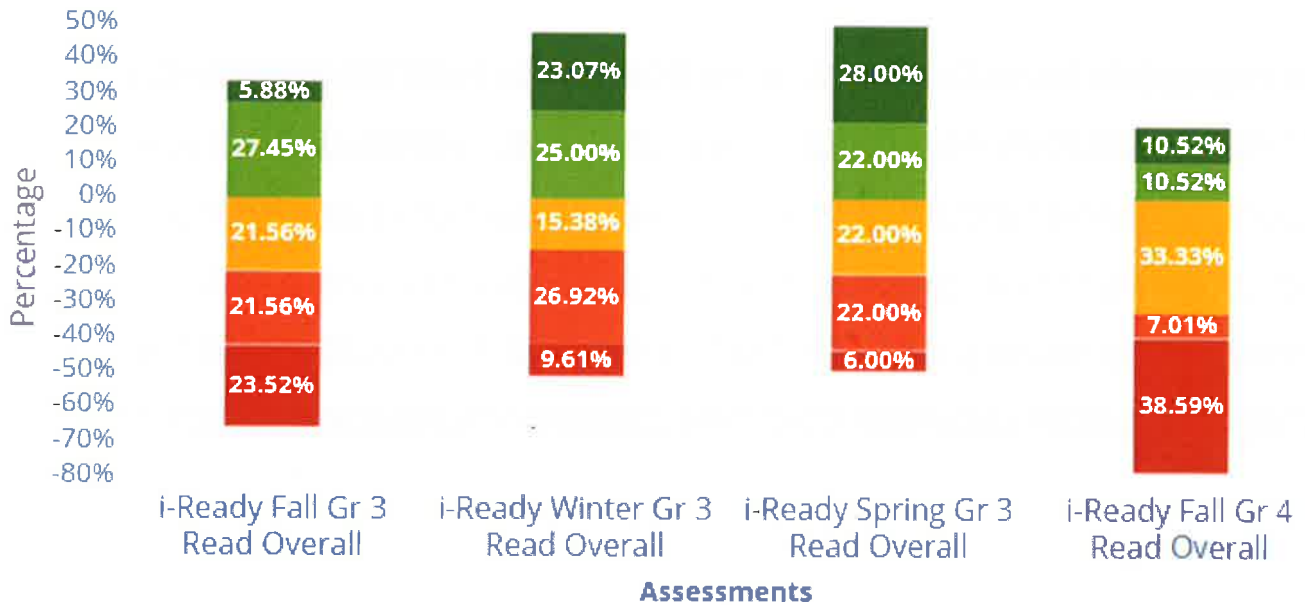

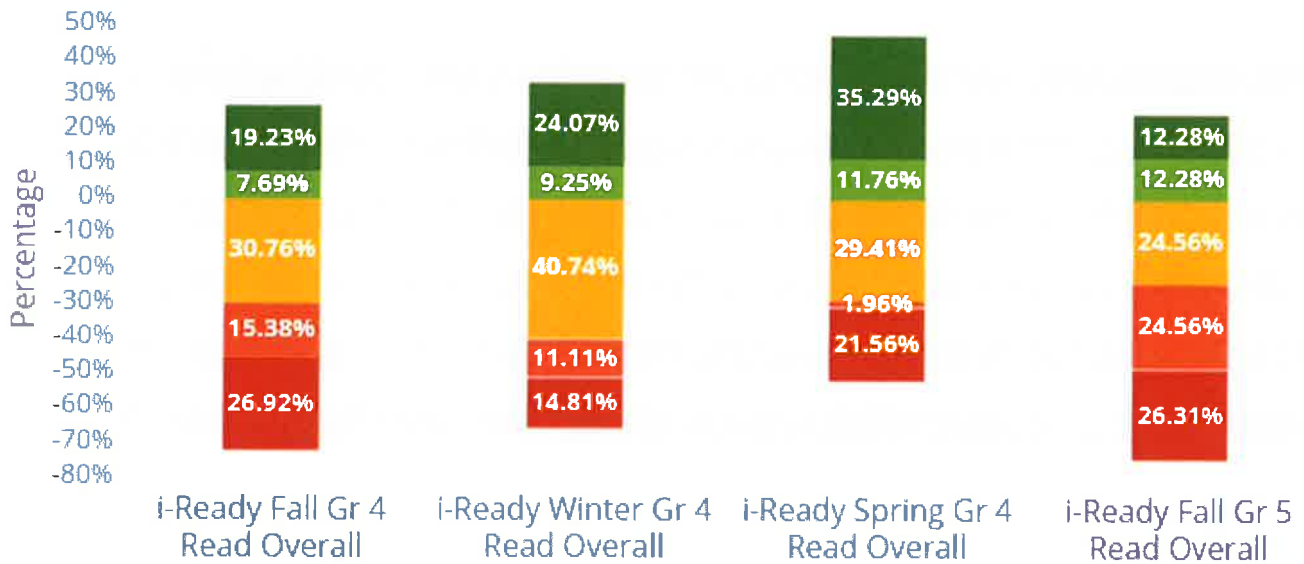

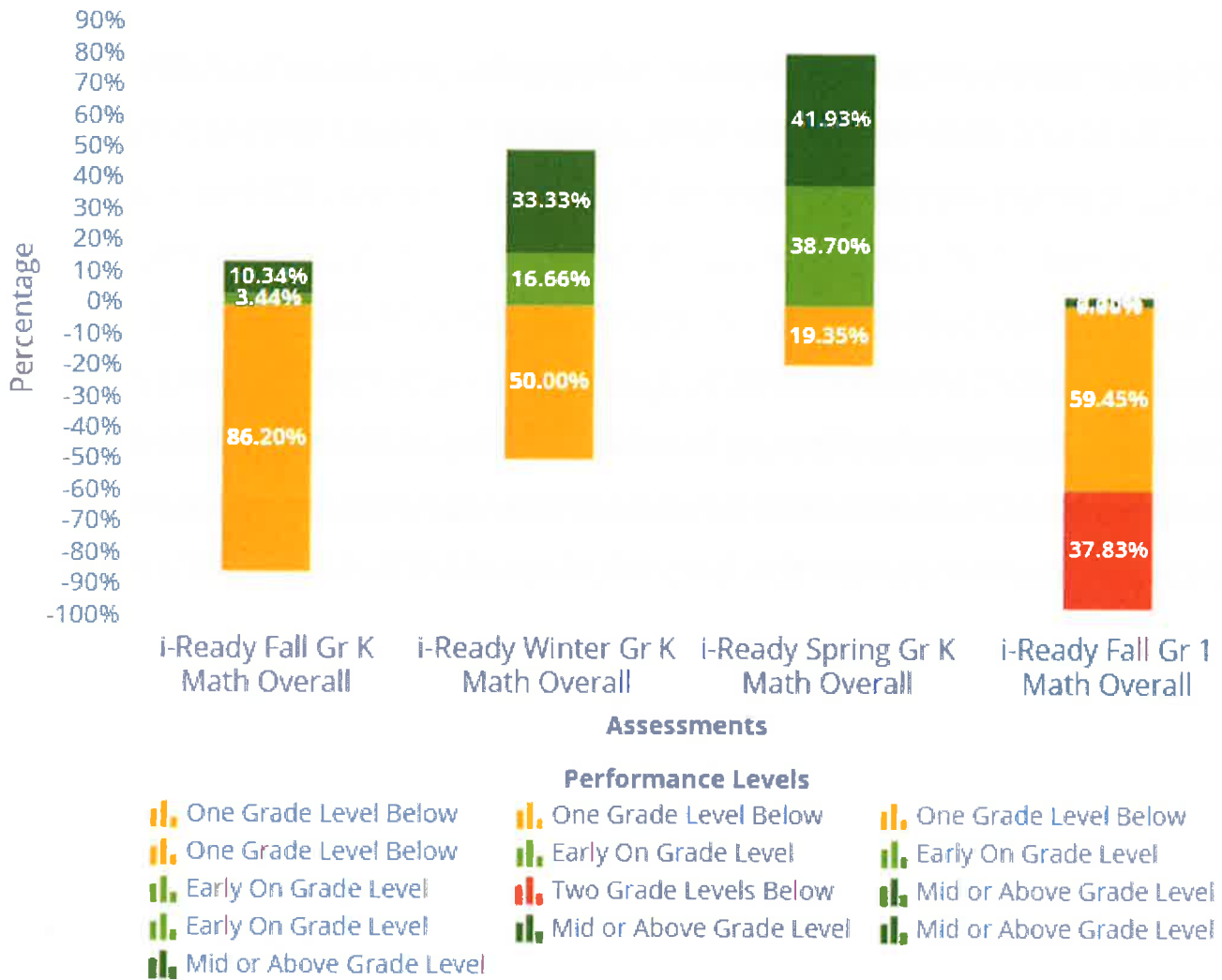

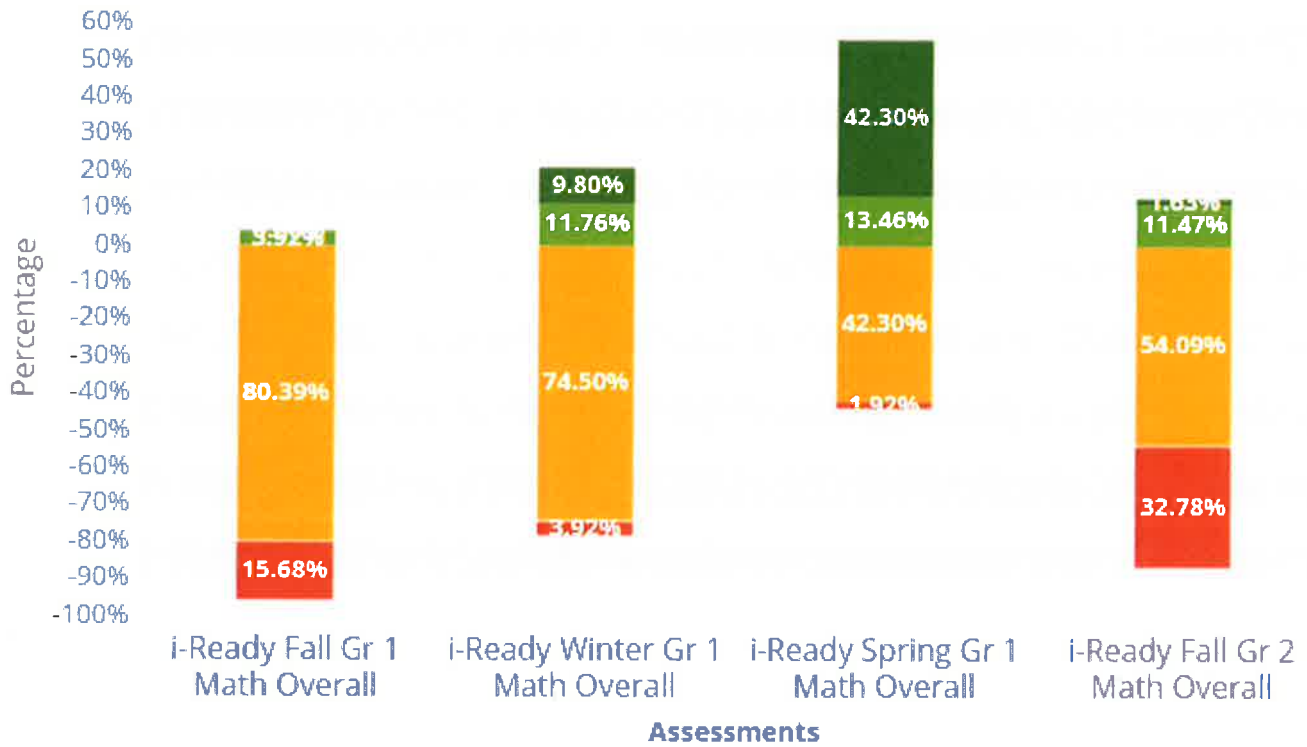

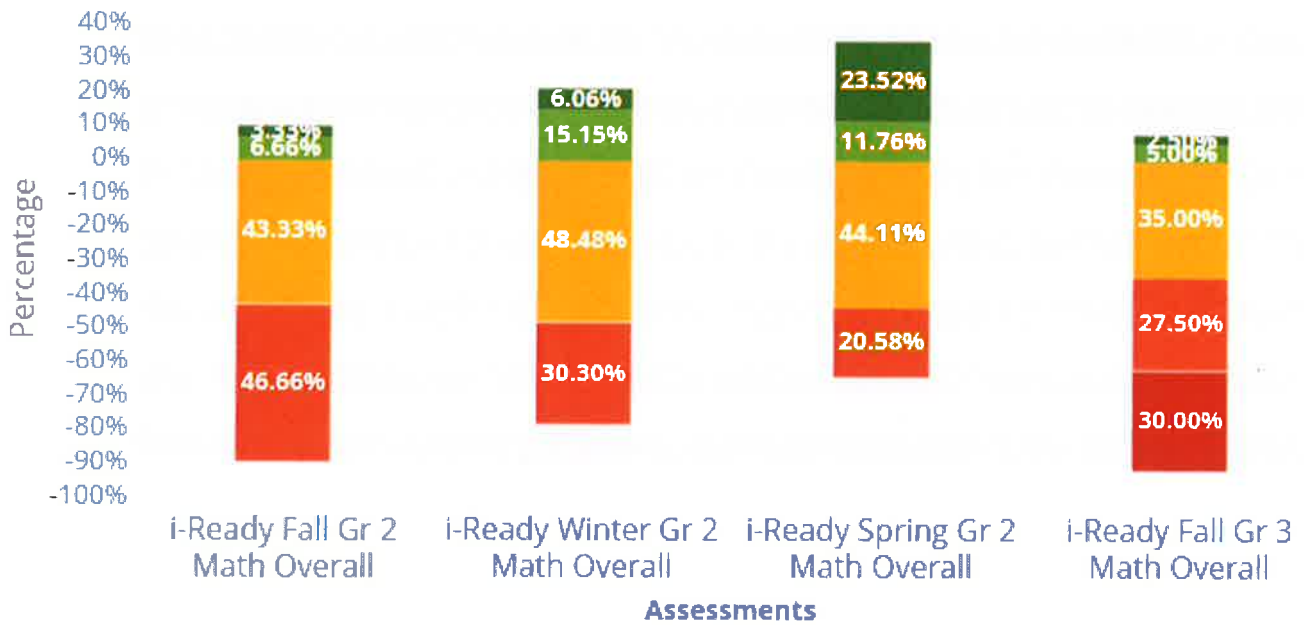

# Annual Performance Level Percentages

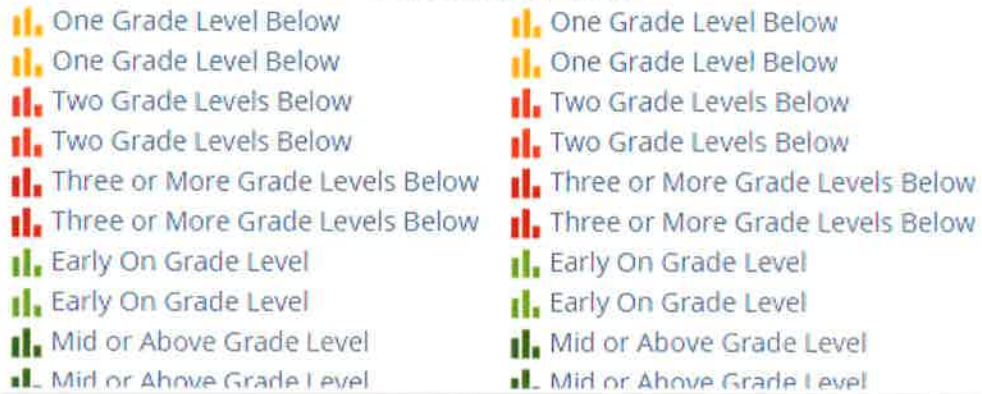


Performance Level Percentages for students in Grade 4 during 23-24

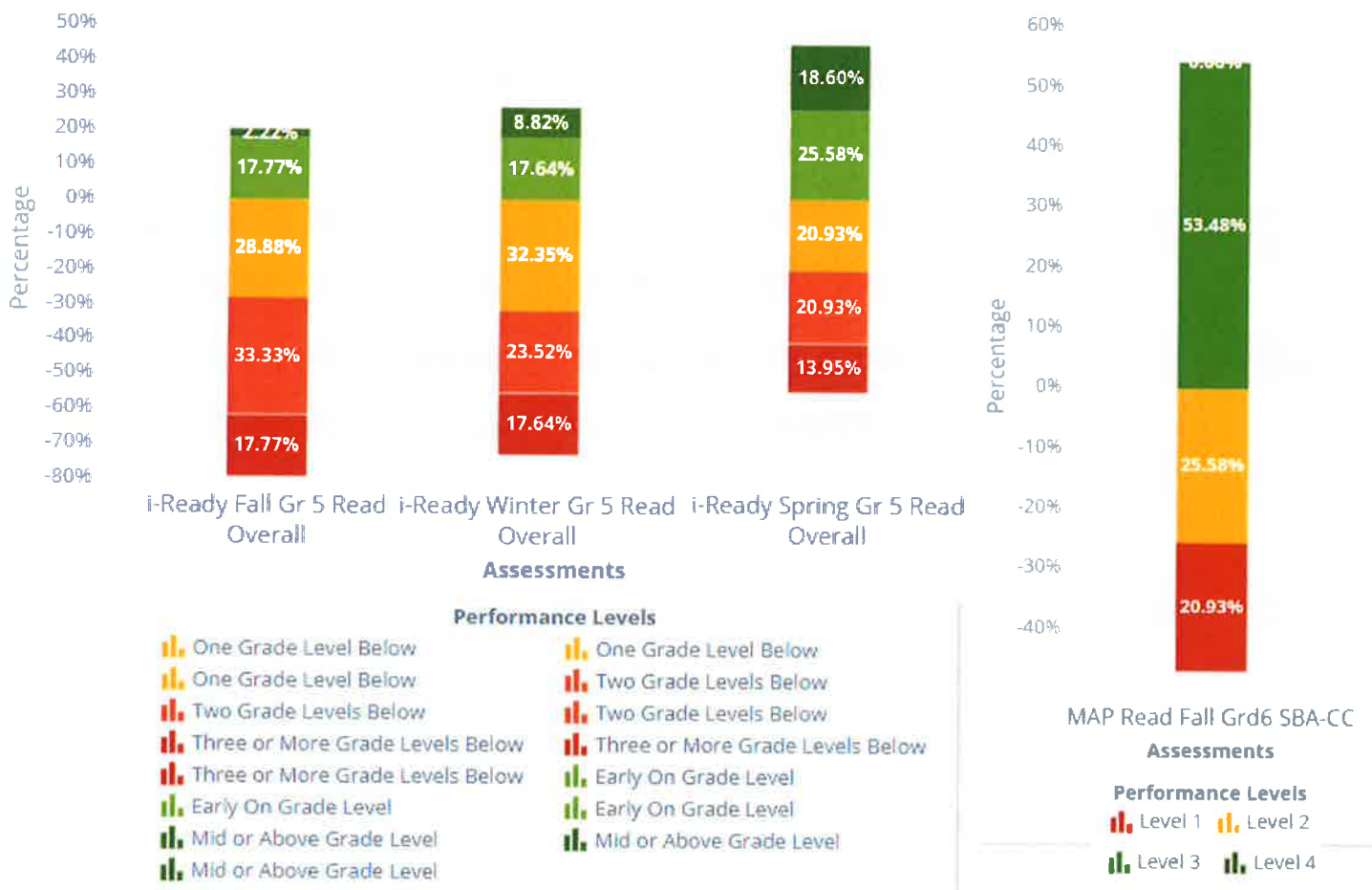

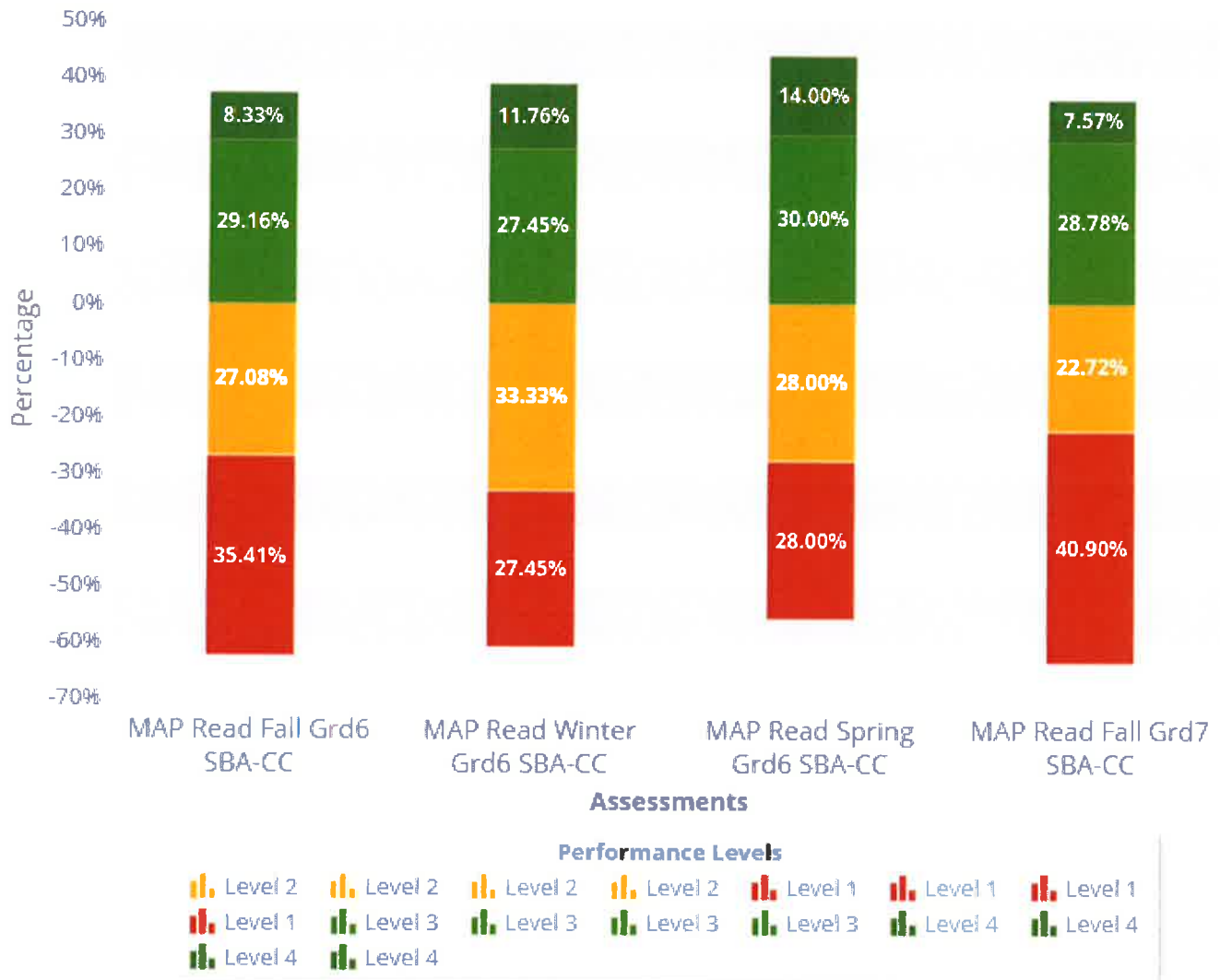

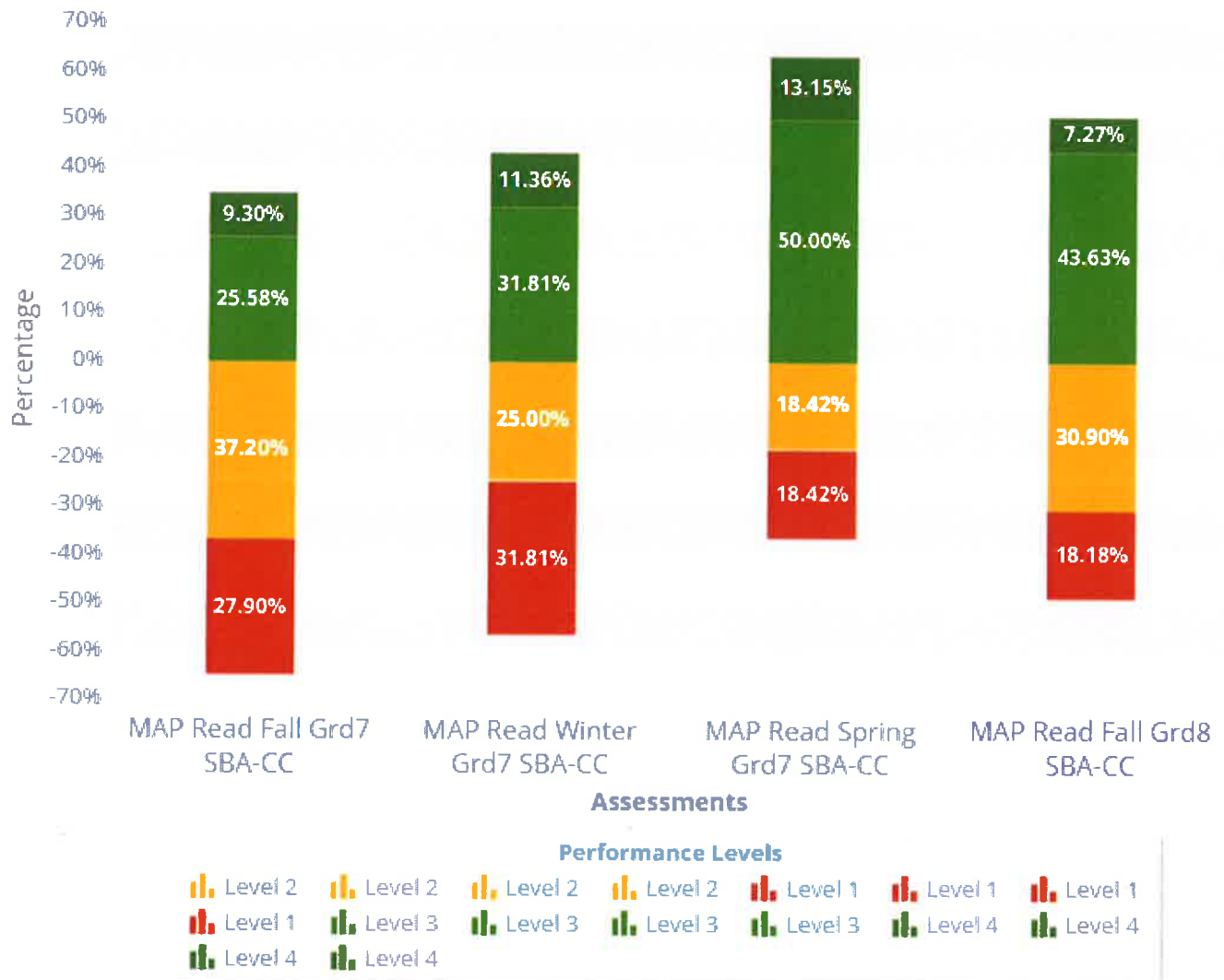

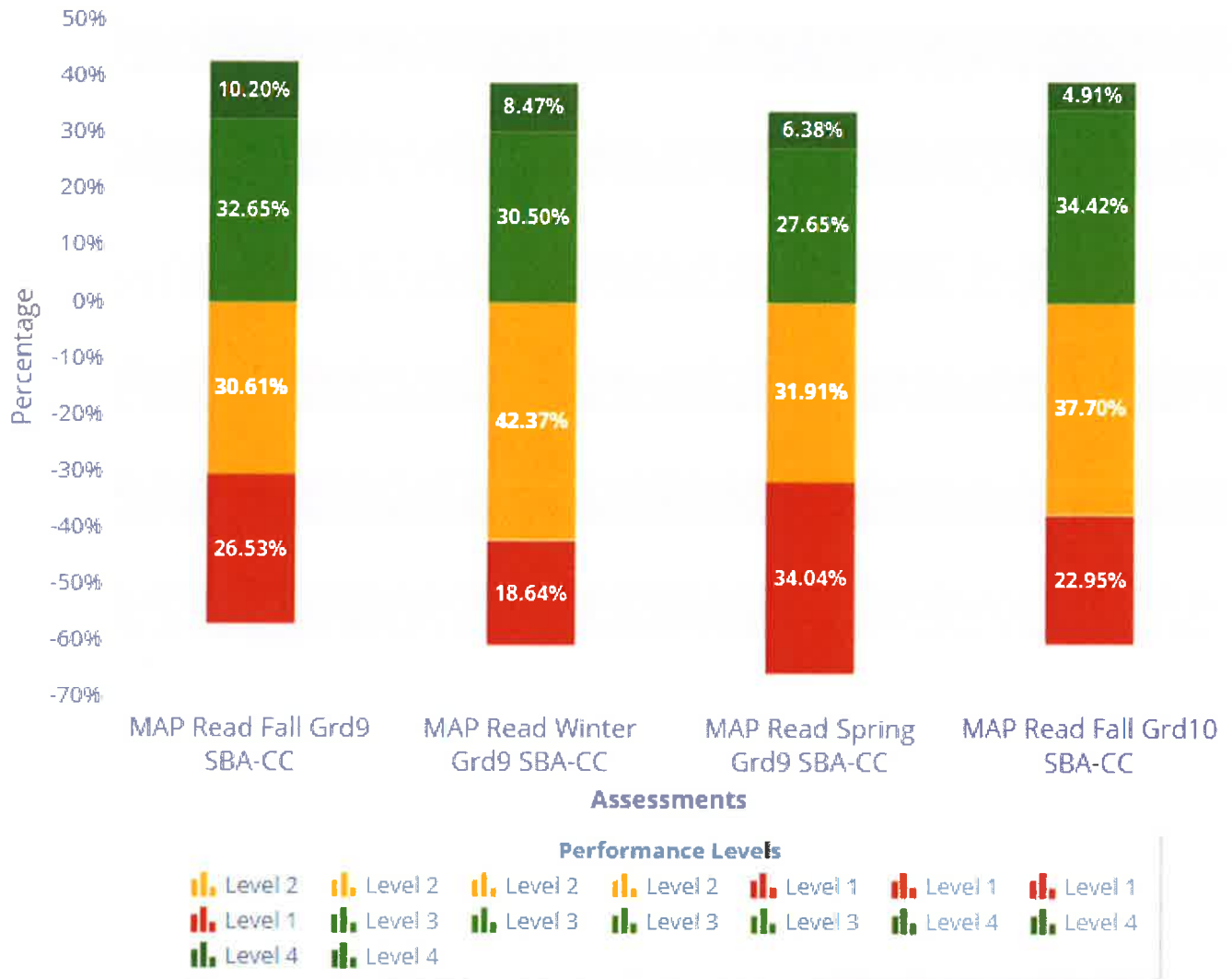

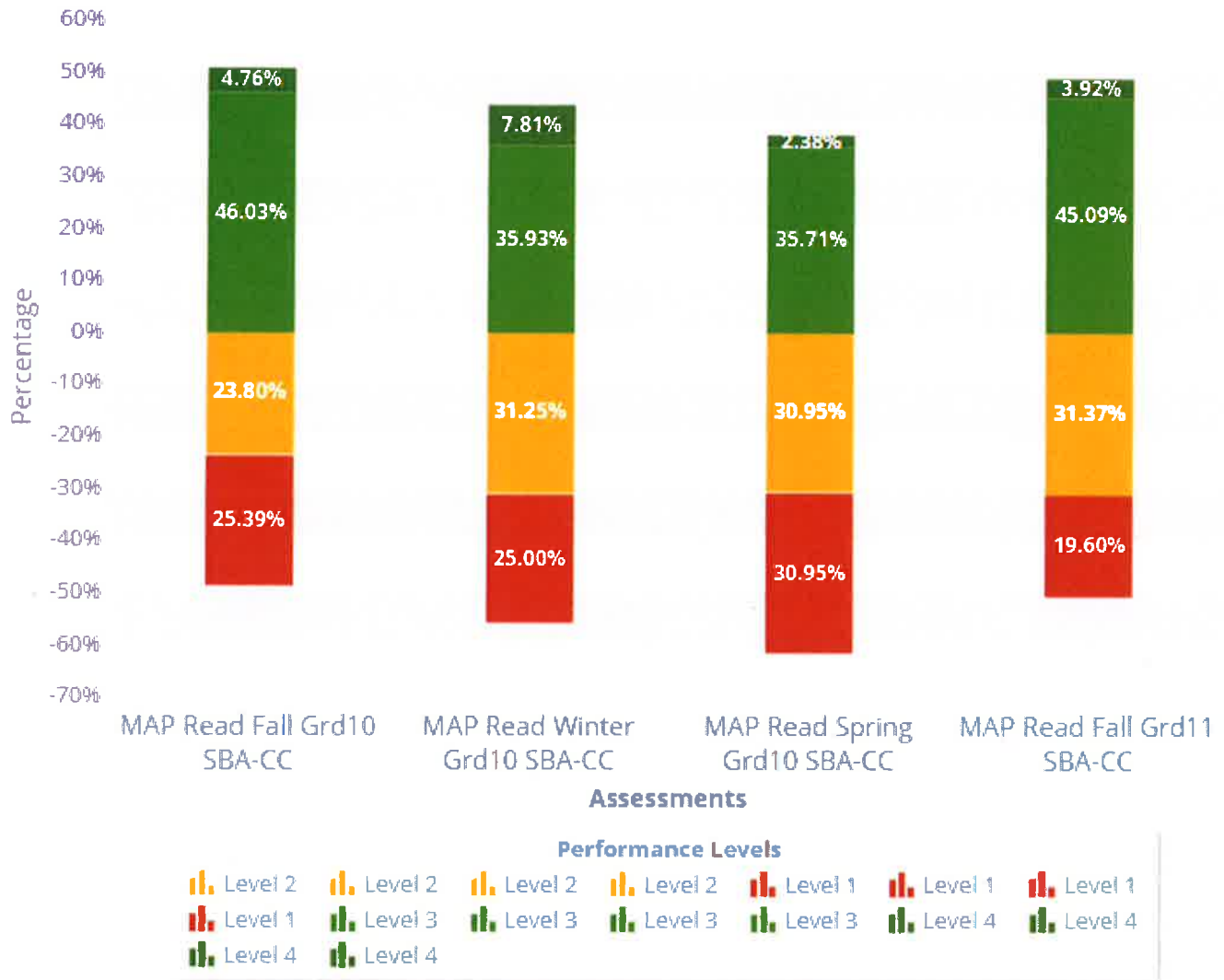

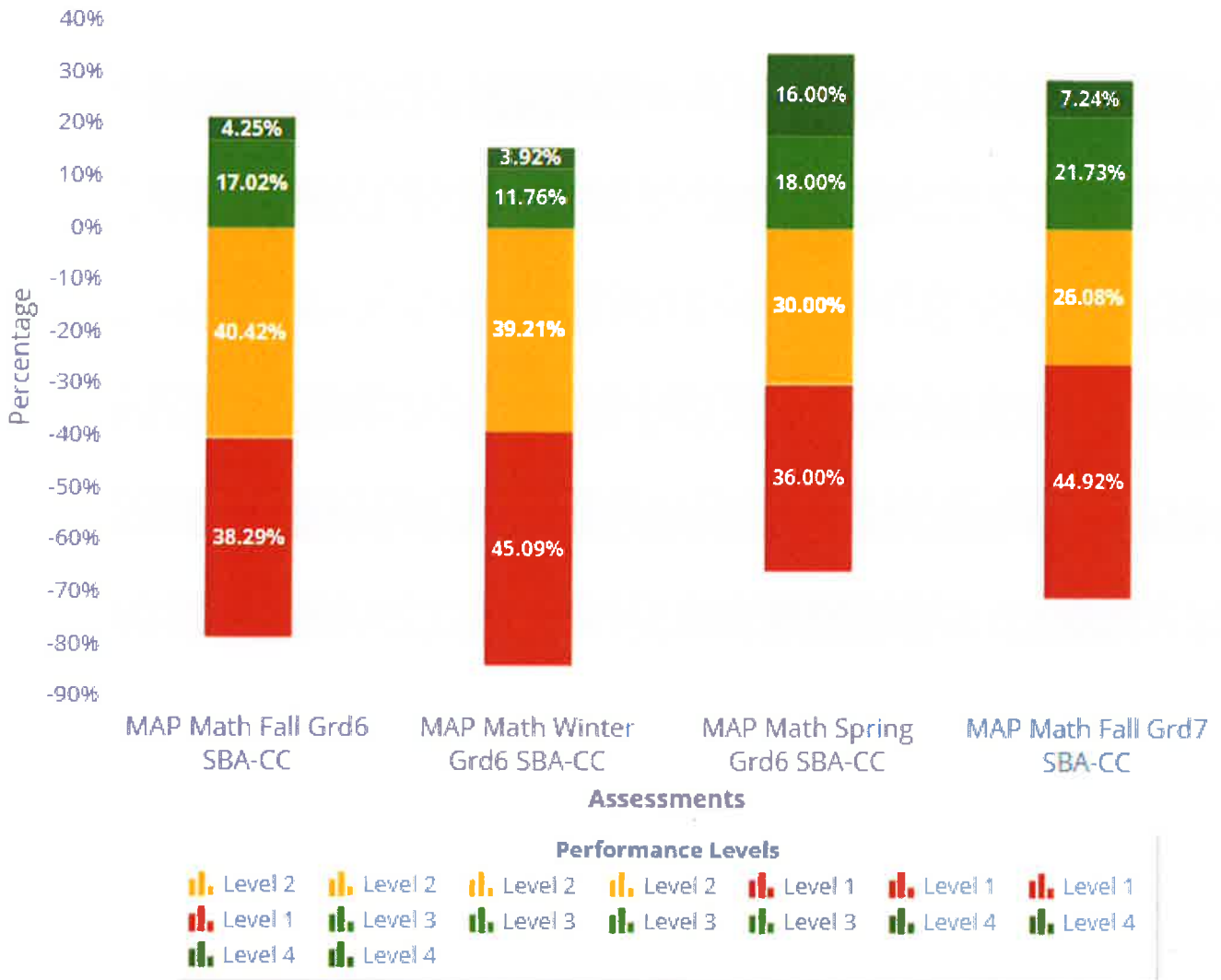

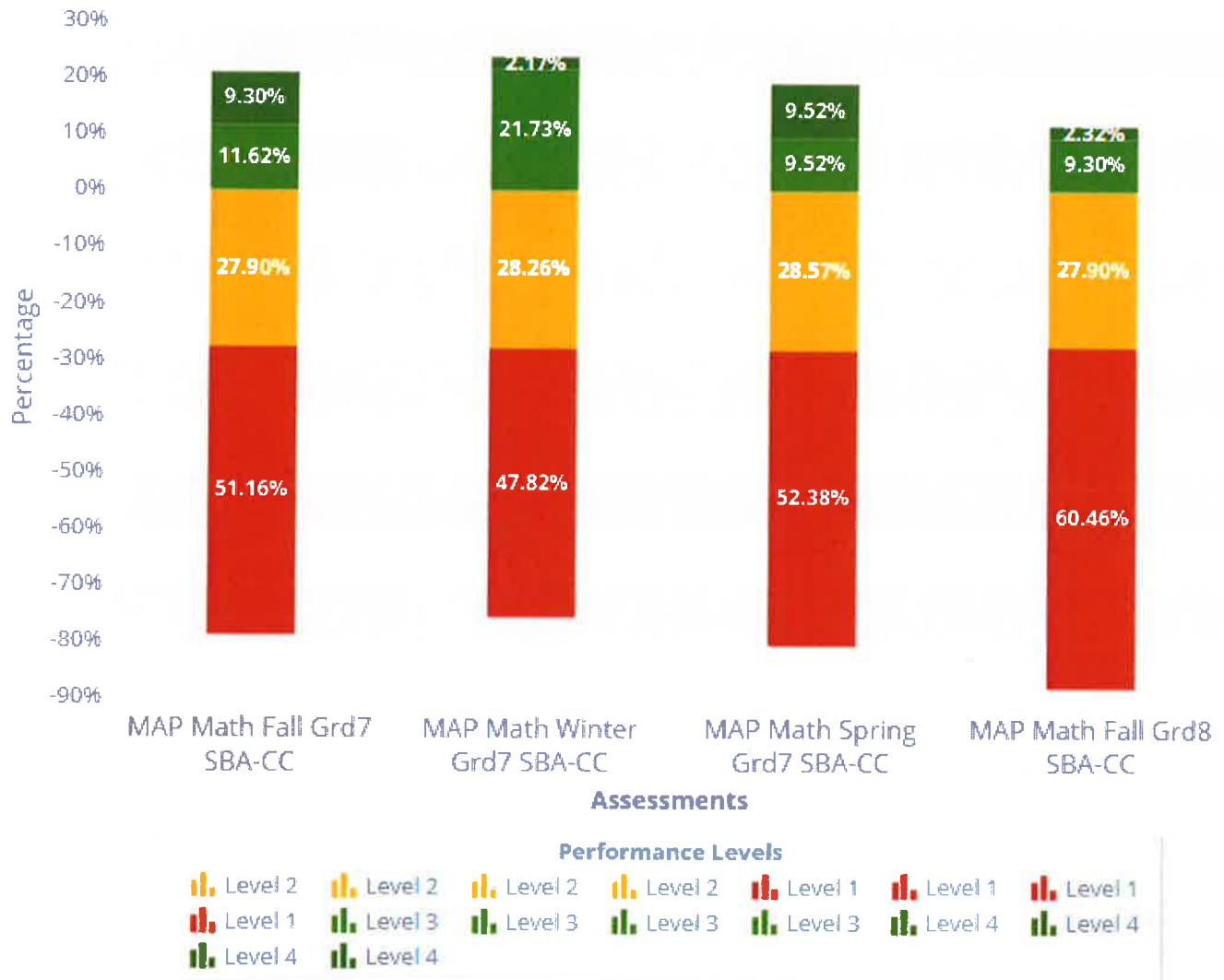

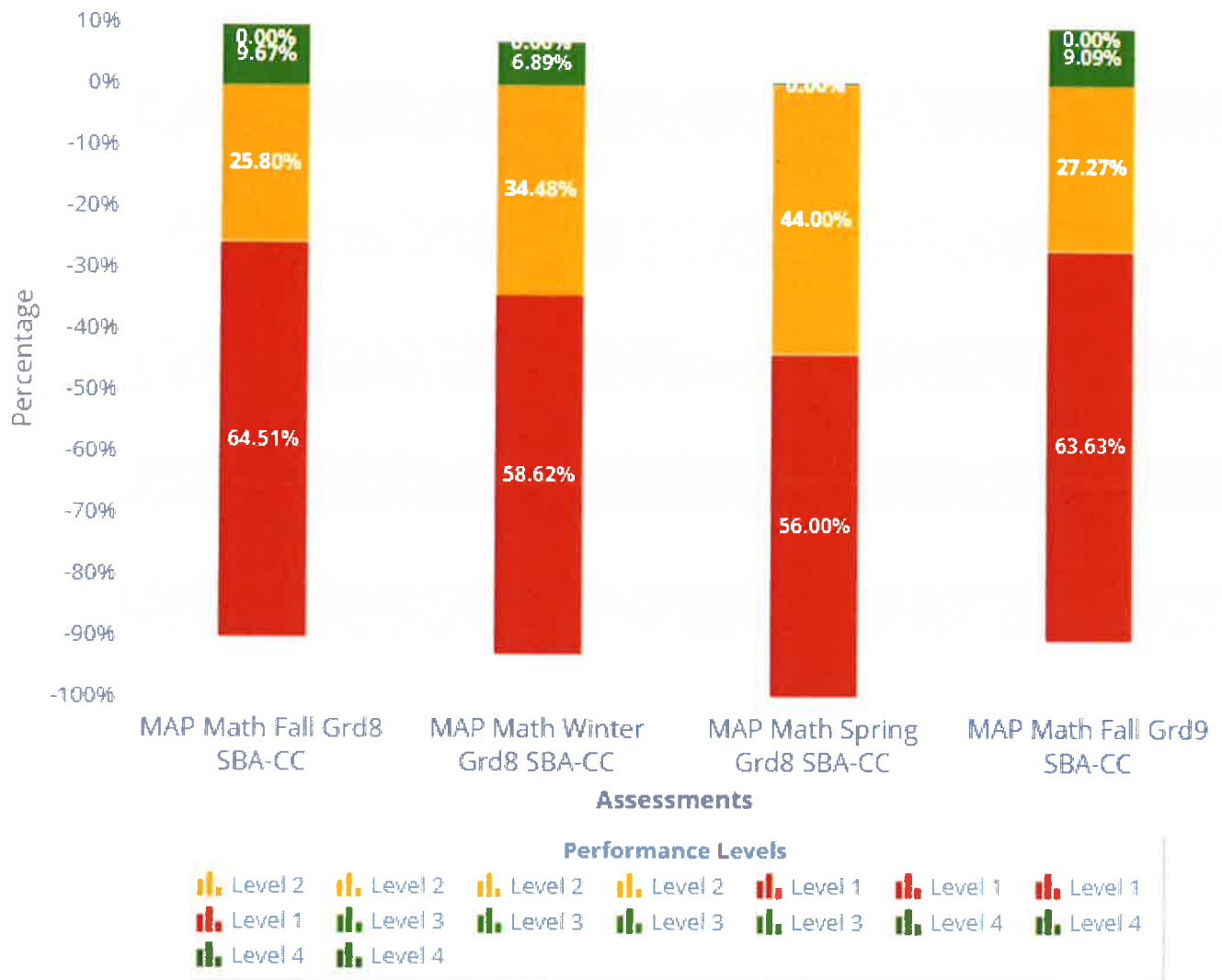

# Annual Performance Level Percentages

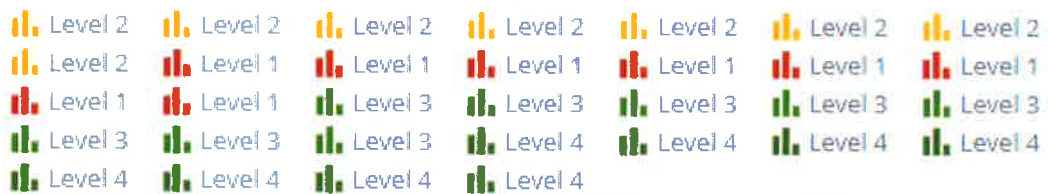


Performance Level Percentages for Students in Chewelah School District (23/24) on MAP Math Subject Assessments

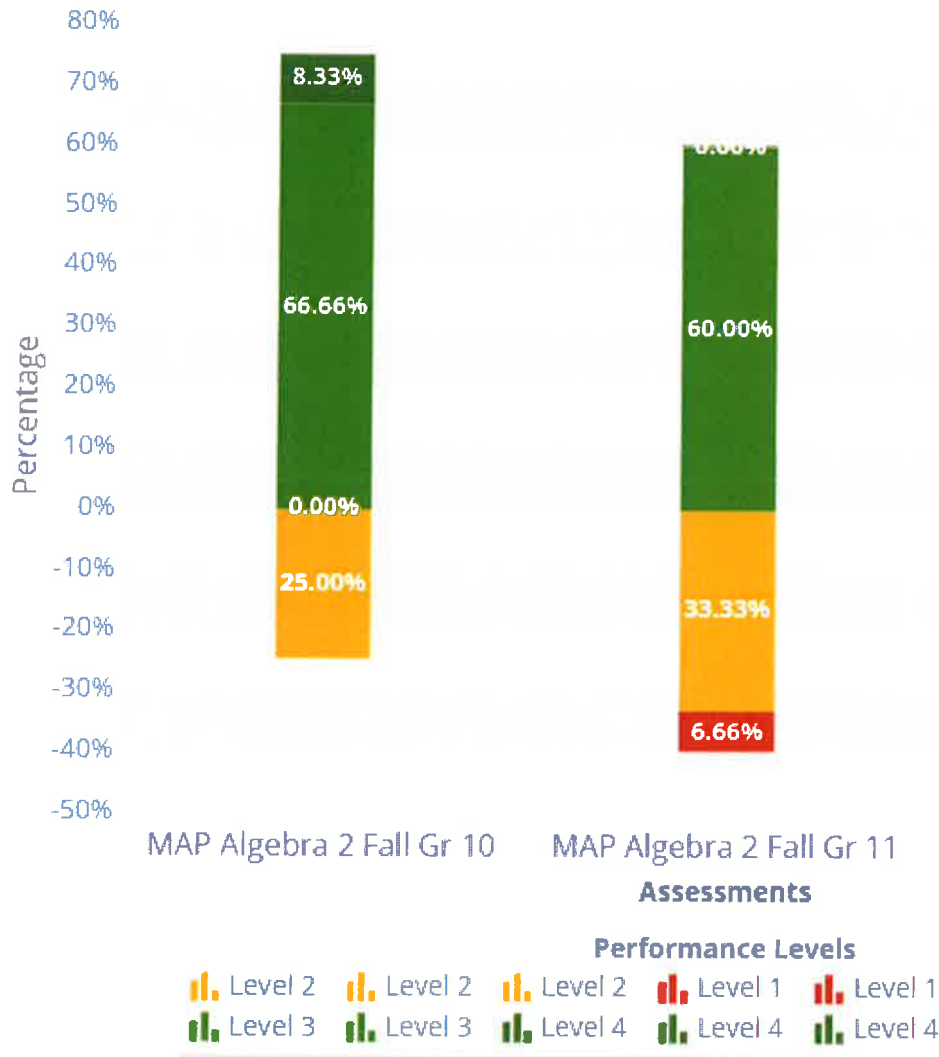

# BOMB or ACTIVE THREAT PROCEDURES

quick reference checklist is designed to help employees and decision makers of commercial facilities, schools, etc. respond to a bomb threat in an orderly and controlled manner with the first responders and other stakeholders.

Most bomb threats are received by phone. Bomb threats are serious until proven otherwise. Act quickly, but remain calm and obtain information with the checklist on the reverse of this card.

### If a bomb or active threat is received by phone:

1. Remain calm. Keep the caller on the line for as long as possible. DO NOT HANG UP, even if the caller does.
2. Listen carefully. Be polite and show interest.
3. Try to keep the caller talking to learn more information.
4. If possible, write a note to a colleague to call the authorities or, as soon as the caller hangs up, immediately notify them yourself.
5. If your phone has a display, copy the number and/or letters on the window display.
6. Complete the Bomb or Active Threat Checklist immediately. Write down as much detail as you can remember. Try to get exact words.
7. Immediately upon termination of call, DO NOT HANG UP, but from a different phone, contact authorities immediately with information and await instructions.

### If a bomb or active threat is received by handwritten note:

Situational Awareness: Consider the Following

- **Close AND Lock doors** – consider barricades, **OR EVACUATE** if safe to do so
- **Turn off lights**

- **Move to entry door wall** (staying away from the door itself) and spread-out
- **Prepare to Counter** (defend/engage) the assailant in door is breached
- **Silence all phones**
- **Do Not** pull the Fire Alarm
- **Stay out-of-sight and remain as quiet as possible**
- **DO NOT leave safe location until released by authorities**
- **Account for students and staff when safe to do so**

### DURING PASSING TIME:

- Proceed to the nearest safe location.
- Begin Lockdown or escape procedures (**LANCE**).

### BEFORE 1<sup>st</sup> PERIOD:

- Proceed to nearest safe location.
- Students can seek shelter outside the building or on a bus if safer than entering the building.
- If a situation develops prior to a bus's arrival, transportation will be notified to proceed to the pre-arranged staging area and await instructions.
- If a situation develops during a bus arrival, the bus driver will depart with the students on the bus and drive to the pre-arranged or safe area.
- Students who have already exited the bus should evacuate and seek safety at a designated safe location.

### DURING CLASS:

- Lock all doors. Barricade!
- Close, lock and cover all windows and glass panels.
- Move to entry-door wall (staying away from the door itself) and spread out if possible.
- Reduce room lights and **everyone** needs to be quiet: DON'T speak – use sign language (finger to lips to be quiet, etc.).
- Maintain a calm atmosphere and provide for the emotional needs of your students.
- **Lockdown:** Do not open doors until released by law enforcement.
- **Evacuate/Escape:** remain in safe location until instructed by officials, superintendent or designee. School bus canvassing will occur in close neighborhoods and be a safe refuge location.
- Report any unusual situations immediately to the building Administrator.

### MEAL/ASSEMBLY TIME:

- Proceed to nearest safe location.
- If in transit to/from cafeteria and/or "commons" area, Lockdown in any available room or evacuate.

### OUTSIDE - P.E. - RECESS: Blue Light

- Staff shall be notified (by cell phone, portable radio, lockdown alarm, blue flashing lights).
- Proceed to a safe public location, and stay away from campus until released by authorities.
- School bus canvassing will occur in close neighborhoods and be a safe refuge location.

### AFTER DISMISSAL:

- Those outside the building should leave the campus and seek shelter.
- If a situation develops during bus loading, the bus driver will leave immediately and drive to the pre-arranged or safe area.

### STAFF WITHOUT STUDENTS:

- Immediately enter any lockable room and quietly await the all clear or Evacuate.
- Staff in the administrative area should quickly go to their building-specific Safe location.

**LOCKDOWN is utilized to protect staff and students using the security of the locked classroom or office location, IF a threat is INSIDE the building.**

**REMEMBER: "LOCKDOWN, LOCKS, LIGHTS, OUT of SIGHT."**

- Move away from interior windows
- Reduce room lights
- Move to entry door wall (staying away from the door itself) and spread-out if possible
- Silence all phones
- *Do Not* pull the Fire Alarm

- If a situation develops during bus loading, the bus driver will load students waiting to board that and immediately drive to the pre-arranged or safe area.

### **STAFF WITHOUT STUDENTS:**

- Immediately enter any lockable room and quietly await the all clear.
- Staff in the administrative area should quickly go to their building-specific Safe location.

## Press Conference Scenario – Teacher Misconduct #1

A 61-year-old, 5<sup>th</sup> grade male teacher in your district was just arrested today on five counts of lewd conduct with five separate children under the age of 16. One of the alleged victims is a former student. The alleged conduct took place over the past six years. The teacher is a 10-year veteran in your school district and is beloved by his students and fellow teachers. The news has sent shock waves through your district. Parents are understandably concerned and angry that their students might also be victims. Social media is lighting up with information that this teacher left a previous job in another state under a cloud of suspicion, even though no charges were ever filed.

The local and regional media is clamoring for information. Your crisis team decides to hold a press conference at 4:00 pm today to address the issue.

Your team has 45 minutes to do the following:

- Step 1 – Draft a statement to read to the media – 1-2 minutes long
- Step 2 – Anticipate the toughest questions you are going to get and develop your responses
- Step 3 - Select a school spokesperson and practice answering the tough questions
- Step 4 – Conduct a press conference

## Press Conference Scenario – Student Protests

Your school district has many Muslim and Jewish students. Recent events in the Middle East have heightened tensions between these students. Last week, a group of Jewish students walked out of class to demonstrate against the Hamas attack on Israel. Yesterday, a group of Muslim students held their own demonstration on school property.

The Muslim protestors were met with a few Jewish students and fights broke out. Several students were injured. The local media covered the event and the footage has gone viral.

The district is facing mounting criticism on how it has handled the situation from school board members, parents and community members.

The local and regional media is clamoring for information. Your crisis team decides to hold a press conference at 4:00 pm today to address the issue.

Your team has 45 minutes to do the following:

Step 1 – Draft a statement to read to the media – 1-2 minutes long

Step 2 – Anticipate the toughest questions you are going to get and develop your responses

Step 3 - Select a school spokesperson and practice answering the tough questions

Step 4 – Conduct a press conference

- Follow your Values – Not your instincts
  - Honesty
  - Openness

- If you have bad news – Be the first to communicate
  - Control the narrative
  - There are no secrets
  - Your first words are the most important

## EMERGENCIES

The Chewelah School District is committed to having current safe school plans and procedures in place to maximize safety for all students and staff. A commitment to safety enables teaching and learning. The District and its schools shall develop comprehensive all-hazard emergency operations plans that address prevention, mitigation, preparedness, response, and recovery strategies.

District and school plans shall:

- Include required school safety policies and procedures;
- Include provisions for the special needs of staff and students;
- Require the building principal to be certified on the incident command system;
- Consider community use of school facilities in emergencies;
- Be annually reviewed with emergency response agencies;
- Conduct inventory of all hazardous materials;
- Identify all staff members who are trained on the national incident management system and the incident command system;
- Collaborate with community agencies to update emergency first aid procedures, including training, use, funding, and placement of public access automated external defibrillators (AEDs);
- Identify school transportation procedures for evacuation;
- Provide information to all staff on the use of emergency supplies and alert procedures;
- Annually record and report information and activities required in subsection 28A.320.125

### **A. Fire Drills**

~~Students shall receive instruction so that in case of fire or sudden emergency they shall be able to leave their particular building in the shortest time possible, or take such other steps as the particular emergency demands, and without confusion or panic. Fire drills shall be held monthly.~~

~~The superintendent is directed to develop emergency evacuation procedures for each building.~~

### **Drills**

Drills are an essential component of safety planning. Drills teach students and staff basic functional responses to potential threats and hazards. The four functional responses are adaptable and can be applied to a variety of situations. Additionally, some threats or hazards may require the use of more than one basic functional response. Therefore, each school in the district will conduct at least one safety-related drill per month, including summer months when school is in session with students. Drill planning and implementation shall consider and accommodate the needs of all students.

### **Basic Functional Drills**

The basic functional responses include shelter-in-place, lockdowns, evacuations, and earthquakes (drop-cover-hold -on):

- **Shelter-in-Place**

Shelter in place is designed to limit the exposure of students and staff to hazardous materials, such as chemical, biological, or radiological contaminants that are released into the environment by isolating the inside environment from the outside. Staff and students will receive instruction so that they will be able to remain inside and take the steps necessary to eliminate or minimize the health and safety hazard.

- **Lockdowns**

Lockdowns are meant to isolate students and staff from threats of violence, such as suspicious trespassers, armed intruders, and other threats that may occur in a school or in the vicinity of a school. Staff and students will receive instruction so that in the event of the breach of security of a school building or campus, staff, students, and visitors will be able to take positions in secure enclosures.

- **Evacuations**

When an emergency within a school or its surrounding area necessitates evacuation and/or total or partial closure of the schools within the district, staff will be responsible for aiding in the safe evacuation of the students within the endangered school or its surrounding area.

Staff and students will receive instruction so that in the event the school or district needs to be evacuated due to threats, such as fires, oil train spills, earthquakes, etc., they will~~shall~~ be able to leave ~~the~~their particular building in the shortest time possible and take the safest route possible to a designated reunification site.

Schools in mapped tsunami or mapped lahar hazard zones, will plan and participate in one pedestrian evacuation drill annually.

### **B. Earthquakes: Drop-Cover-Hold on**

The Board recognizes the importance of protecting staff, students, and facilities in the event of an earthquake. Facilities ~~will~~~~shall~~ be designed and maintained in a manner that recognizes the potential danger from such an occurrence. Likewise, staff must be prepared to take necessary action to protect students and staff from harm.

“Drop – cover – hold on” is the basic functional earthquake response. The superintendent ~~will~~~~shall~~ establish guidelines and the action ~~fortaken~~by building principals to take should an earthquake occur while school is in session.

### **Additional Drills**

In addition to the above four functional response drills, the District shall, at a minimum, also develop response plans for the following:

- **Pandemic/Epidemic**

The Board recognizes that a pandemic outbreak is a serious threat that could affect students, staff, and the community. The superintendent or a designee ~~shall~~ will serve as a liaison between

the school district and local health officials. The district liaison, in consultation with local health officials, shall will ensure that a pandemic/epidemic plan exists in the district and establish procedures to provide for staff and student safety during such an emergency.

When an emergency within a school or its surrounding area necessitates evacuation and/or total or partial closure of the schools within the district, staff shall will be responsible for aiding in the safe evacuation of the students within the endangered school or its surrounding area.

**C. Bomb Threats**

The superintendent willshall establish procedures for action in the event that any threat is received toward the school by telephone, letter, orally, or by other means.

**D. Emergency School Closure or Evacuation (Modified Shelter-in-Place)**

When weather conditions or other circumstances make it unsafe to operate schools, the superintendent is directed to determine whether schools should be started late, closed for the day, or transportation will be provided only on emergency routes. Those decisions will be communicated through community media resources pursuant to a plan developed by the superintendent or designee.

The superintendent shall will establish procedures for the emergency closure of a building or department.

All safety plans and drills shall include protocols for both internal and external communications, as well as procedures for drill documentation. Evacuation plans shall also include reunification plans. Schools shall document the dates and time of such drills. Each school will maintain the time and type of drill in the school office.
